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MY RESEARCH IS RESPONDING TO HIGH RATES OF STOMACH BUGS REPORTED AMONG ETHNIC MINORITY POPULATIONS, PARTICULARLY THOSE OF SOUTH ASIAN ETHNICITY IN BLACKBURN AND SURROUNDING AREAS.

SOUTH ASIAN EXPERIENCES ARE VERY MUCH UNDER-RESEARCHED, ESPECIALLY IN BLACKBURN AND SURROUNDING AREAS. THIS CONTRIBUTES TO A LACK OF REPRESENTATION IN PUBLIC HEALTH RESEARCH PREVENTION.

I AM HOPING TO LEARN FROM OTHER PAKISTANIS, INDIANS AND BANGLADESHIS ABOUT THEIR EXPERIENCES OF MANAGING A STOMACH BUG, DIARRHOEA OR VOMITING.
